MOTION WITHOUT NOTICE

03/2023 To move that the Honourable Minister for Labour and Social Security should consider instituting a Commission of Enquiry to establish the following:

- (a) whether labour laws were complied with during the transition leading to the conversion of Chevron Eswatini to Puma Eswatini with regards to employees who exited during the transition and some who transferred to the new entity. The period under scrutiny is post 31st August 2014;
- (b) whether labour laws were complied with during the transition leading to the conversion of Eswatini Beverages into AB-Inbev Eswatini with regards to employees who exited during the transition and those who transferred to the new entity. The period under scrutiny is post October 2016; and
- (c) any incidental matters related to the above issues.

The Honourable Minister to further submit a report within a period of twenty one (21) days after adoption of this motion.
