THE REPORT SHOULD ALSO INCLUDE THE MEASURES THAT HAVE BEEN PUT IN PLACE, OR WILL BE PUT IN PLACE, TO AVOID THE RECURRENCE OF THE SIMILAR CIRCUMSTANCES. HIS EXCELLENCY THE RT. HON. PRIME MINISTER SHOULD SUBMIT THE REPORT WITHIN FOURTEEN (14) DAYS AFTER THE ADOPTION OF THIS MOTION.
